Approval of minutes from May 6, 2021, Public Hearing:

Councilman Lea moved to approve the Minutes of the May 06, 2021 public hearing as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilman Carr and approved by all present voting in favor.

**Ordinance – OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MACON, MISSOURI
ANNEXING A CERTAIN ADJACENT, UNINCORPORATED AREA INTO THE
CITY OF MACON, MISSOURI:**

No objections were filed related to the voluntary annexation petition submitted by Caleb and Amy Dwiggins for annexation of 29352 Kellogg Avenue. Approval of the annexation ordinance is the final Council action step in the annexation process. Once passed and approved, the City Clerk will record the ordinance at the Macon County Recorder's Office and distribute certified copies of the ordinance to the Missouri Department of Revenue (taxation division), Macon County Clerk, and Macon County Assessor.

R-1 Residential One-Family Dwelling District will be the zoning of the newly annexed property.
